Word: River	
Definition	What it is NOT
A large, natural stream of water flowing in a channel to a sea, lake, or another such stream.	Ocean Lake
Sentence with word	Illustration
The Missouri River starts in Montana and eventually flows into the Mississippi River.	A long stretch of water surrounded by trees with a bridge overtop

Word: Mountain Range	
Definition	What it is NOT
A line of mountains connected by high ground	Hill
Sentence with word	Illustration
The mountain range is so tall that it looks like it goes on forever.	A line of mountains varying in size

Word: Continent	
Definition	What it is NOT
A very large area of land	Island
Sentence with word	Illustration

We live on the continent of North America.	A big area with trees surrounded by water
